


'Glorious Growing'

Dear Parents,

Welcome back, we hope you had a relaxing Easter break and are now ready for the summer term.

Our topic is 'Glorious Growing!' During this term, we will be looking at how people, plants and mini beasts grow. We will be using stories to help us learn and to develop our knowledge and understanding.

Our key texts this term are:



Literacy: Our focus in literacy this term is for children to recognise their names. The rising 5s are going to learn and practice writing their name and know the letter sounds, we will also be exploring different types of books.

Maths: In maths, we are going to focus on recognising and ordering numbers from 1-10, as well as measuring different objects.

The main part of the topic will focus on growing, planting and the world around us. We will explore these through planting our own seeds and watching them grow and change.

Home Learning


Our rising 5's will have a book folder this term, inside will be a sound book for them to practice and a reading book, please share these together and comment in the record book.
