'Under the sea'






Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope you have had an enjoyable half term and are ready for Term 6, before some of our children move on to Reception!

This term, we are going to enjoy a water-filled fun learning journey. We will be enjoying finding out about what happens down by the sea. We will be looking at lots of different fish and other animals that live under the sea, and find out about what goes on the sea.

Some of our key texts this term will be:



Areas of Learning:

Literacy - We will continue to focus on our phonics, listening to the initial sound in words and trying to blend them. We will be creating role plays of stories, asking the children to be active learners and working together as a team.

Maths - In Maths, we will be looking at number recognition and knowing the representation of the number. We will be doing lots of counting and recognising shapes within our environment and will also be looking at some adding and subtracting.

In other areas of the EYFS, we will be making links with our water theme, such as learning about things that float and sink and why this happens. Our Personal, Social and Emotional Development will begin to focus on transition to Reception and we will be taking part in lots of activities which make us more familiar with the classroom and school. We will be practising getting school uniform on and off so that the children are ready for Reception and their PE sessions. We will be getting creative and using our imagination to produce lots of art work.

This term, we will be seeing Mr Brett for PE sessions each week.
